

Mixed Doubles Tournament

USBC Certified

Tournament Date/Time: April 27, 2019 at 11:30am, Check-in opens at 10:30am.

Entry Fee: \$120.00 (\$60.00 per bowler x2). \$95.00 Prize Fund, \$25.00 Lineage & Tournament Expenses.

Eligibility: This is a mixed doubles event. All doubles teams must consist of 1 male and 1 female bowler.

Format: Qualifying will consist of 4 regular games, moving pairs after each game. Following qualifying, the top 8 teams will be seeded based on qualifying position into a bracket finals (1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc). All bracket matches will be the best of 3 Baker style games with the first team to win 2 games advancing.

Ties: Tie for seed position will be broken by awarding the team with the highest single game scratch earning the higher seed. If tie still exists, coin flip will determine higher seed. Ties in the bracket finals games will require a full Baker style tie-breaker game.

Sponsorship: Tournament champions will win two brand new Columbia300 bowling balls!!

Baker 300 Bonus: Any team shooting a Baker 300 game with both bowlers throwing an Ebonite International bowling ball, will win a \$1,000 bonus.

Tournament Rules:

1. All bowlers must be current USBC members in good standing.
2. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
3. Entering average:
 - a. Highest 2017-18 season USBC league average of 21 games or more.
 - b. If no average last year, use highest current season USBC average at the time of entry for 21 or more games. Bowlers using a current season average must bring a league average verification from their league secretary or dated standings sheet.
 - c. Bowlers with neither of the above averages must bowl scratch.
 - d. Averages from USBC Sport Leagues will be accepted. Additional rerate may apply.
 - e. PBA, PWBA and Team USA members are eligible to participate.
4. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average in handicap tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler or their partner. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game.
5. Reporting of previous tournament winnings will not apply.
6. All decisions of the tournament manager are final.
7. Entries close at 11:30am on April 27, 2019 or when filled. This is a one day only event.
8. Prize list is based on 48 doubles entries. All prize money will be returned 100%. One in 4 entries will cash. Prize list will be pro-rated if less than 48 teams.
