

# Mixed Doubles Tournament

## USBC Certified

Tournament Date/Time: March 16, 2024 at 11:30am, Check-in opens at 10:30am.

Entry Fee: \$130 (\$65 per bowler). \$105 Prize Fund, \$25 Lineage & Tournament Expenses.

Eligibility: This is a mixed doubles event. All doubles teams must consist of 1 male and 1 female bowler.

Format: Qualifying will consist of 4 regular games, moving pairs after each game. Following qualifying, the top 12 teams will be seeded based on qualifying position into a single elimination bracket finals, with the top 4 teams receiving a bye. All bracket matches will be 2 Baker style games, highest total pins wins.

Ties: Tie for seed position will be broken by awarding the team with the highest single game scratch earning the higher seed. If tie still exists, "Rock, Paper, Scissors" to determine higher seed. Ties in the bracket finals games will require a full Baker style tie-breaker game.

### Tournament Rules:

1. All bowlers must be current USBC members in good standing.
2. Handicap will be 90% of 220.
3. Entering average:
  - a. Highest **STANDARD COMPOSITE** 2021-22 or 2022-23 season USBC league average of 27 games or more, whichever is highest.
  - b. USBC Sport League averages (sport conversion), Open Championship averages (sport conversion), Women's Championship averages (challenge conversion), and Collegiate averages (sport conversion) of 21 games or more will be considered and accepted at Tournament Manager's discretion. Additional rerate may apply.
  - c. If none of the above averages, use highest current season USBC average at the time of entry for 21 or more games. Bowlers using a current season average must bring a dated league standing sheet.
  - d. Bowlers with neither of the above averages must bowl scratch.
  - e. Tournament Management reserves the right to refuse any average or bowler and has the right to rerate any bowler. If the rerated average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded before bowling.
  - f. PBA, PWBA and Team USA members are eligible to participate.
4. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average in handicap tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler or their partner. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the correct average. However, corrections in averages may be permitted up to the completion of the first game.
5. Reporting of previous tournament winnings will not apply.
6. All decisions of the tournament manager are final.
7. Entries close at 11am on March 16, 2024 or when filled. This is a one day only event.
8. Prize list and first round cut are based on 48 doubles entries. All prize money will be returned 100%. One in 4 entries will cash. Prize list will be pro-rated if less than 48 teams.
